Unfortunately being a small group, we were not given audience from any decision taking parties. So our pleads remained unheard.

It is no secret to anybody that your competitor was favored by **political motivations**.

Today, new management is in, but we are back to square one, as it seems **they have no funds!**

Paying the staff salaries for September, seemed to have been very painful to management. We are still not ordering stocks. Vehicles are still without fuel. We are still buying commodities (for personal use, things like toilet tissue paper, coffee, water, etc) we feel ashamed of this situation, but it's the reality.

There are also rumors that in January 2016 another group of staff will be sacked!

We don't know how long this Company will survive. We no longer have any motivation for our work.

Our purpose of writing is, to inform you that we have been sold to a group who has no funds, to put the company back on track!

We are begging you to contact Mr Isaacs to try to convince him to sell us out to you.
