I have just visited the hunger strikers at the Jardin de la Compagnie.

I have been given to understand that the Police has contacted the spouse/children and/or parents of the hunger strikers to take a statement from them in relation to their salaries/wages.

Statements has even been recorded from some of them.

There is no legal basis for the Police to take such a cause of action.

I would be most grateful if you could put an end to this harassment of the spouse/children and/or parents of the hunger strikers who are fasting rightfully for their rights.

If ever, the Police still wants to record a statement from the spouse/children and/or parents of the hunger strikers, kindly contact me so that proper legal advice can be given to them.

I trust that good faith will prevail in a year where the Police Force is celebrating its 250th anniversary.
